
Leader's Guide: WHAT YOU WEAR

• Discuss why faithfulness in a soldier is so important to success in battle.

• If workers on a job are unreliable or not trustworthy what measures must an owner pursue in order to ensure the success of his company?

• While we may not think of each day as a spiritual battle, why is it a good idea to begin each day by readying ourselves with the belt of truth (faithfulness)?

• From a practical standpoint, how do we wear this spiritual belt of truth and how do we make sure that it stays on?

Pages 101 - 104

• Going into a battle without armor covering the front of our body would be foolish. Spiritually why would we allow sin to remain unconfessed, which is the same as not wearing the breastplate of righteousness?

• As a side note for the story on page 101, Joshua and Caleb could have been extremely angry that the other ten people gave a bad report on the Promised Land and as a result they had to wait 38 more years as well. They surely would have been tempted to go ahead and enter the land with the rebels. Discuss what prevented them from being so presumptuous.

• Is it barely possible that while we remain in the spiritual doldrums, not owning up to our sin, that we can compound this state by further pursuing other sinful actions because we may not care at the moment? How can we be yanked out of this depressing sinful state?

• On page 103 the question is asked: Who are the Big Three of Righteousness? Who are they and why do we think the Lord credited them with such a high honor?

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Helmet

Pages 105 - 108

• Going into a battle without a helmet is not wise. In a spiritual sense, what type of attacks are we vulnerable to if we do not wear the helmet of salvation?

• Ask the group to discuss the following statement on page 105: *We cannot lose our salvation if it is genuine, but the accuser will try his best to make us doubt the legitimacy of our salvation.* What thoughts make us doubt the reality of our eternal forgiveness and salvation?

• We can struggle with being involved in ministry, and in spiritual battles, if we have experienced failures in the past. We may hope that God has forgiven us, but we doubt that others have forgiven us. How can a firm belief in God's forgiveness remove the fear of people's judgments and opinions?

• From a practical standpoint, how do we put on this spiritual helmet of salvation and how do we make sure that it stays on?

• Discuss the group's answers to the homework on page 107.
